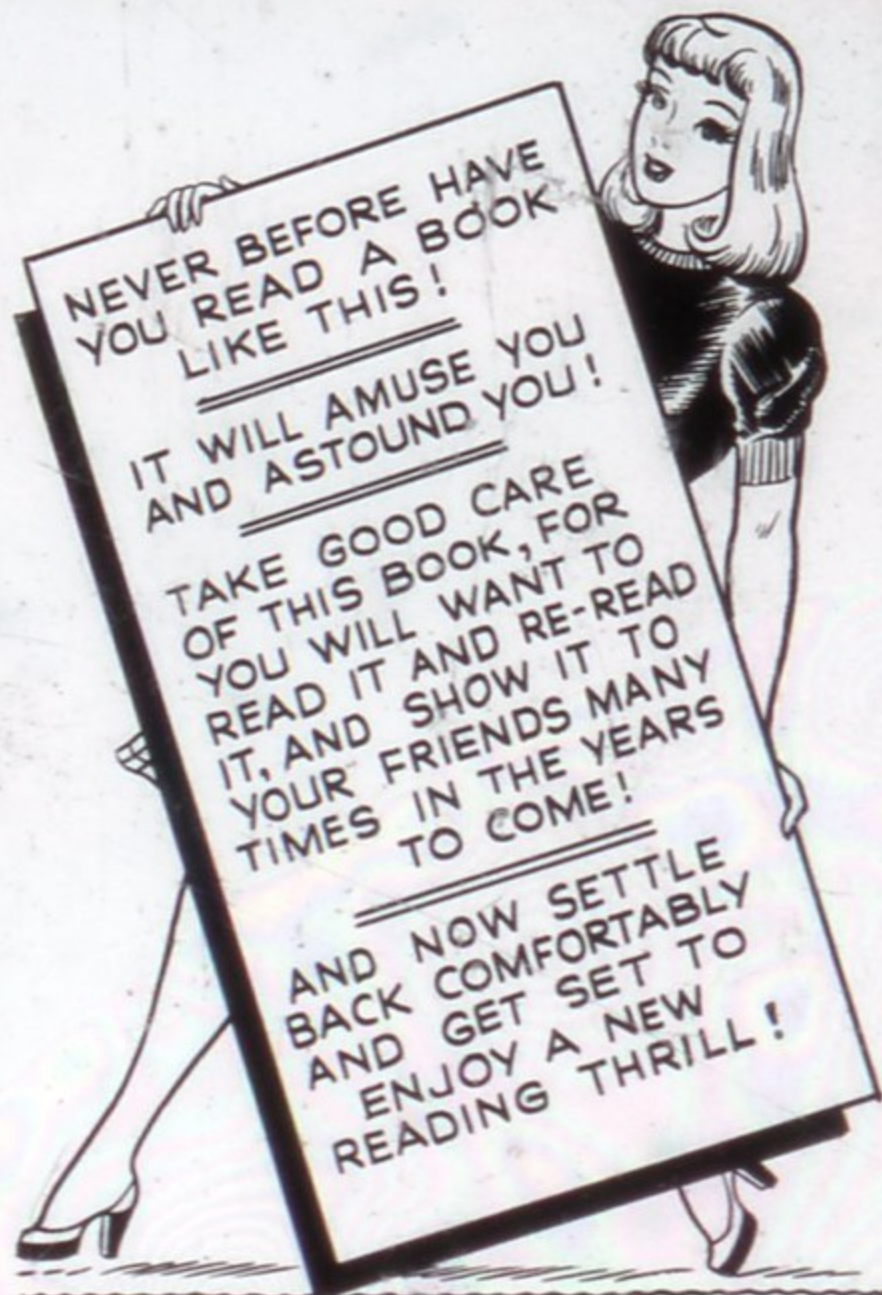

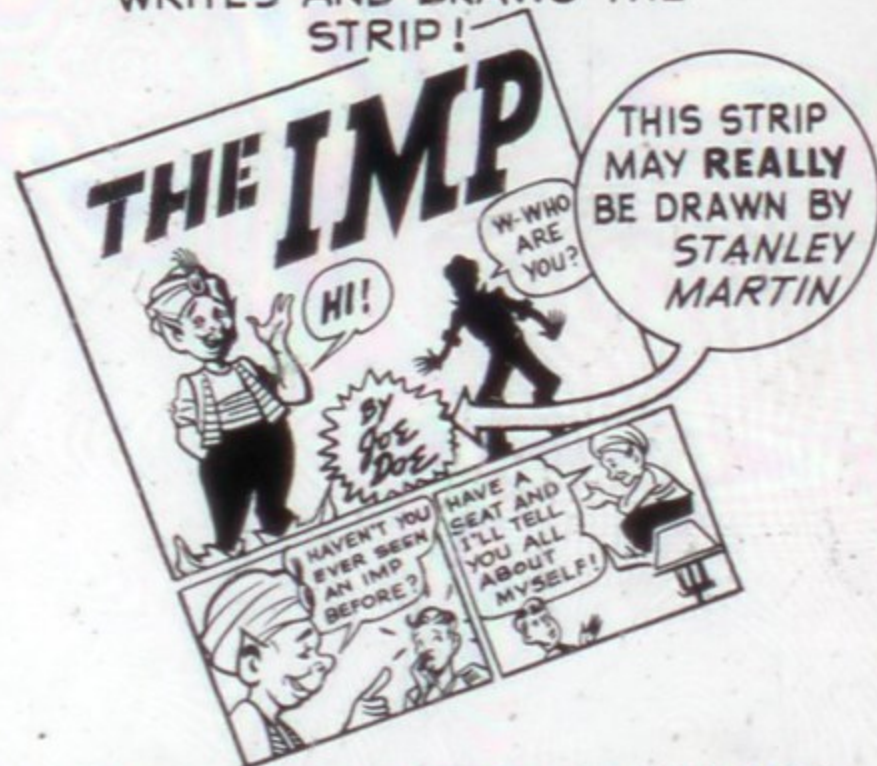

WHO WRITES AND DRAWS THE COMICS?

THE ANSWER TO THIS QUESTION WILL
SURPRISE YOU! THE ANSWER IS:

THE MAN WHOSE NAME
IS SIGNED TO A COMIC
STRIP IS **NOT ALWAYS**
THE MAN WHO **REALLY**
WRITES AND DRAWS THE
STRIP!



THEN **WHY** ARE FALSE NAMES
SOMETIMES USED?



FALSE NAMES ARE SOME-
TIMES USED BECAUSE A
COMIC STRIP MAY HAVE
MANY ARTISTS! ONE
ARTIST MAY CREATE A
COMIC STRIP...THE STRIP
MAY GROW SO POPULAR
THAT THE ONE ARTIST
WHO CREATED IT CANNOT
DRAW ALL THE STRIPS
NEEDED. SO, THE EDITOR
HIRES ANOTHER ARTIST
TO DRAW THE SAME
STRIP. BUT THE FIRST
ARTIST WANTS HIS NAME
ON **ALL** THE STRIPS! SO,
EVEN THOUGH THE NEW
ARTIST DRAWS SOME
STRIPS, THE NAME OF
THE FIRST ARTIST WILL
APPEAR ON ALL OF THEM!

Remember: YOU CANNOT
ALWAYS TELL WHO WRITES
OR DRAWS A COMIC STRIP
BY LOOKING AT THE NAME
WHICH IS SIGNED!
IT MAY BE THE WRONG
NAME OR A FICTITIOUS
NAME!

SECRET NO. 4

HOW TO DISCOVER
WHO IS THE *REAL*
ARTIST OF A COMIC
STRIP!

THE ONLY WAY TO REALLY
TELL IS BY LEARNING TO
RECOGNIZE ARTISTS' *STYLES*



EVERY ARTIST HAS
HIS OWN *DIFFERENT*
STYLE OF DRAWING!

NO TWO ARTISTS
EVER DRAW
EXACTLY ALIKE!

SECRET NO. 5

HOW TO RECOGNIZE ARTISTS' STYLES



NOTICE THAT THERE ARE LOTS OF BACKGROUND DRAWINGS IN EDWARD WINIARSKI'S PAGE... THAT IS, LOTS OF HOUSES, FURNITURE, PEOPLE, CLOUDS, ETC. IT IS PART OF ED'S STYLE TO USE MANY BACKGROUNDS. THAT IS ONE GOOD WAY TO RECOGNIZE ED'S DRAWINGS!

Also YOU CAN SEE HOW MANY FOLDS ED DRAWS IN HIS FIGURES. IN THE PICTURE OF GABBY IN PANEL #4, DO YOU SEE ALL THE FOLDS IN GABBY'S PANTS AND COAT? THIS IS CALLED "PUTTING IN LOTS OF DETAIL" AND IT IS ANOTHER WAY TO RECOGNIZE ED'S STYLE!

CAN YOU SPOT ANY OTHER HABITS OF DRAWING WHICH ED HAS, WHICH VIC DOESN'T HAVE? HINT: LOOK AT THE WAY ED CONSTRUCTS HIS FIGURES, AND AT THE WAY VIC CONSTRUCTS HIS FIGURES...

HERE IS VIC'S PAGE OF HEDY DEVINE....

NOTICE THAT HE DOES NOT USE NEARLY AS MANY BACKGROUNDS AS ED...



Also NOTICE THAT WHILE ED DRAWS LOOSELY IN LINE AND TONE, VIC DRAWS CLEANLY AND ALMOST ENTIRELY IN LINE

Ed's STYLE OF DRAWING IS CALLED "DETAILED", BECAUSE HE PUTS IN SO MANY DETAILS OF BACKGROUNDS, CLOTHES, ETC.

Vic's STYLE OF DRAWING IS CALLED "LINE DRAWING" BECAUSE HE ONLY DRAWS THINGS IN LINE WITH SOME SUGGESTION OF TONE

Remember NO TWO ARTISTS EVER DRAW EXACTLY ALIKE! BY STUDYING LITTLE DETAILS LIKE BACKGROUNDS, FOLDS, SHOES, HANDS, ETC. YOU CAN USUALLY TELL IF THE SAME ARTIST, OR TWO DIFFERENT ARTISTS DREW TWO STRIPS!

SECRET NO. 6

DOES THE SAME
PERSON WHO
WRITES A COMIC
STRIP ALSO DRAW IT?

THIS IS A QUESTION WHICH HAS
PUZZLED COMIC MAGAZINE
READERS FOR A LONG TIME!

THE ANSWER IS:
SOMETIMES, BUT NOT
ALWAYS!

SECRET NO. 7

HOW DO ARTISTS AND WRITERS WORK TOGETHER?

FIRST, LET'S ANSWER SOME
OF THE QUESTIONS WHICH
ARE MOST COMMONLY ASKED...

1. DO THE ARTIST AND WRITER
HAVE TO LIVE TOGETHER?

ANSWER: NO!

2. DO THE ARTIST AND WRITER
HAVE TO BE GOOD FRIENDS?

ANSWER: NO!

3. DO THE ARTIST AND WRITER
EVEN HAVE TO KNOW EACH
OTHER?

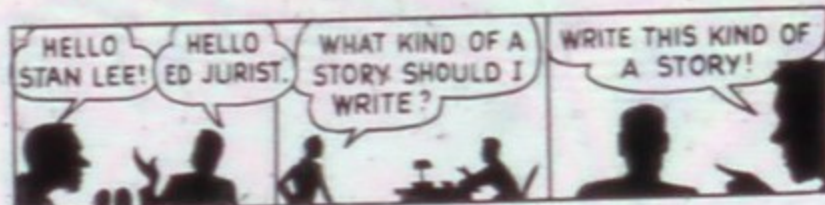
ANSWER: NO!

WELL THEN, YOU WILL ASK,
IF THEY DON'T HAVE TO
LIVE TOGETHER, AND IF THEY
DON'T HAVE TO BE GOOD
FRIENDS, OR TO EVEN KNOW

THE ARTIST AND THE WRITER!

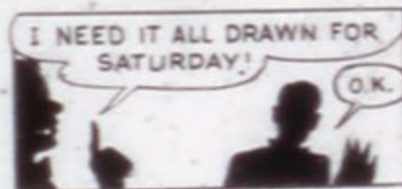
Here's How It's Done...

SECRET NO. 8

HOW ARE COMIC SCRIPTS WRITTEN?

IT TAKES A LONG, LONG
TIME TO LEARN TO WRITE A
COMIC STRIP, FOR IT IS A VERY
UNIQUE AND UNUSUAL FORM
OF WRITING!



COMIC STRIPS ARE NOT
WRITTEN LIKE STORIES
OR LIKE SCHOOL COMP-
OSITIONS. THEY AREN'T
JUST A LOT OF WORDS
WHICH FORM SENTENCES
AND PARAGRAPHS!

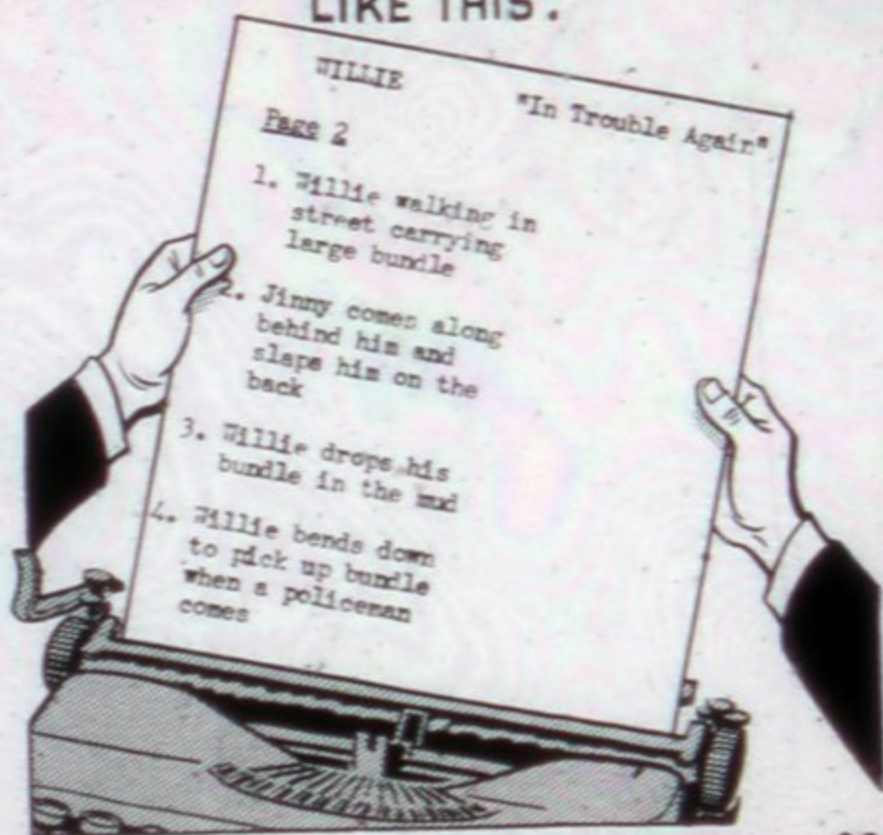
NOW, FOR THE FIRST
TIME EVER IN THE WORLD,

THE FIRST THING FOR THE WRITER
TO REMEMBER IS THAT HE IS WRITING
THE COMIC SCRIPT FOR AN ARTIST
TO ILLUSTRATE!

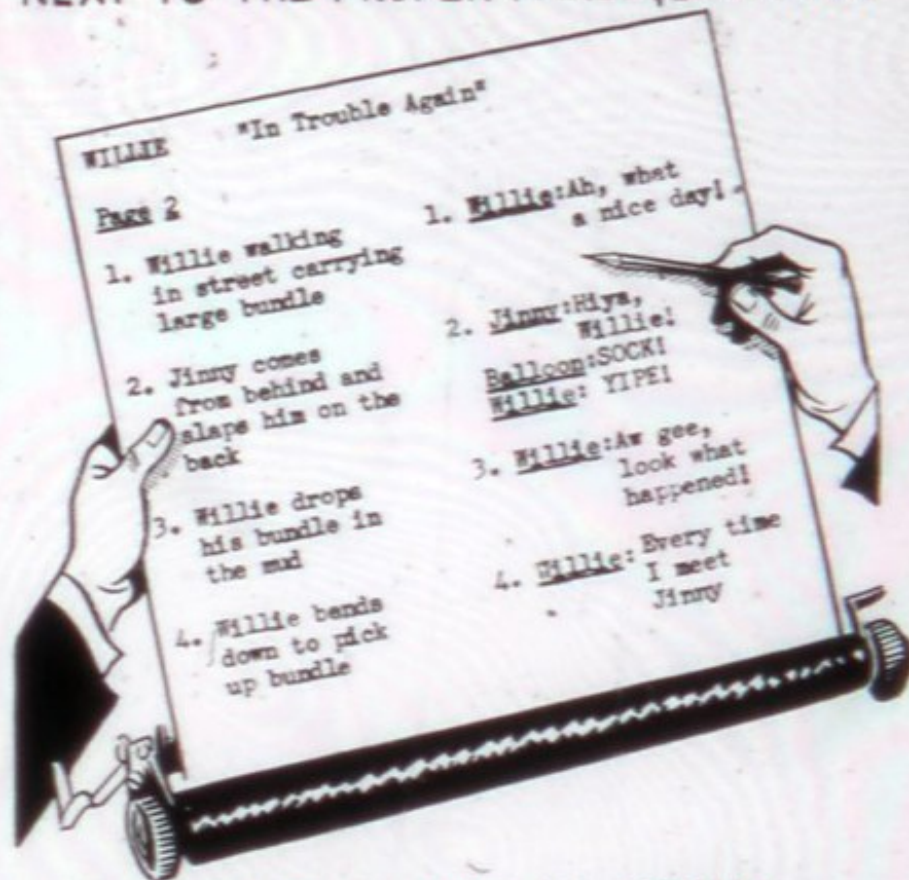
SO, THE WRITER MUST TELL
THE ARTIST WHAT PICTURES
TO DRAW PANEL-BY-PANEL!

IN ORDER TO TELL THE ARTIST WHAT TO
DRAW, THE WRITER WRITES BRIEF DEScri-
PTIONS DOWN ONE HALF OF THE PAGE,
LIKE THIS:



THEN, AFTER ALL THE DESCRIPTIONS ARE WRITTEN, THE WRITER MUST ADD THE DIALOGUE (WHAT THE CHARACTERS SAY IN THE SCRIPT!)

THE DIALOGUE FOR EACH PANEL IS WRITTEN IN THE EMPTY COLUMNS NEXT TO THE PROPER PANEL, LIKE THIS:



AND THAT IS WHAT AN ACTUAL PAGE OF A REAL SCRIPT LOOKS LIKE!!!

**SECRET
NO. 9**

WHAT HAPPENS TO A SCRIPT AFTER IT IS WRITTEN?

AT THIS POINT, WE'RE GOING TO FOLLOW THE SCRIPT WHICH THE WRITER HAS WRITTEN, AND SEE HOW IT BECOMES A FINISHED COMIC STRIP!

FIRST, IT GOES TO THE EDITOR! THE EDITOR READS IT CAREFULLY!



HE CHECKS TO MAKE SURE THAT THE SCRIPT IS FUNNY,

- . INTERESTING,
- . EASY TO UNDERSTAND,
- . ENJOYABLE,
- . WELL WRITTEN...

IF IT ISN'T GOOD ENOUGH TO SATISFY HIM, THE EDITOR GIVES IT BACK TO THE WRITER AND HAS HIM WRITE IT OVER AGAIN UNTIL IT'S GOOD!

SECRET No. 10

HOW ARE COMIC STRIPS DRAWN?

THIS IS THE QUESTION WHICH IS ASKED
MORE OFTEN THAN ANY OTHER!

And NOW FOR THE
FIRST TIME EVER
IN THE WORLD,
STAN LEE WILL
GIVE YOU THE
ANSWER!

ON THE PAGE BEFORE THIS ONE,
WE SAW THAT THE EDITOR GOT
THIS SCRIPT FROM THE WRITER
AND CHECKED IT TO MAKE SURE
IT WAS GOOD ENOUGH TO BE DRAWN!



AFTER THE SCRIPT IS
GOOD ENOUGH TO BE
DRAWN, THE EDITOR
MUST GIVE IT TO THE
ARTIST!

But...

THE SCRIPT IS SOMETIMES
GIVEN TO **MORE THAN
ONE ARTIST!!!** AND NOW,

HERE IS A VERY IMPORTANT SECRET
BEHIND THE COMICS...

THERE MIGHT BE AS
MANY AS **THREE
ARTISTS** ALL
DRAWING THE SAME
COMIC STRIP!!!

HOW? YOU ASK!!!
HERE'S HOW:

FIRST, COMES ARTIST
NUMBER ONE. HE IS
THE **PENCILLER**

MEET KIN PLATT!
KIN IS THE CLEVER
PENCILLER OF THE
"RUSTY" COMIC
STRIP!



THE "PENCILLER" IS THE FIRST ARTIST TO GET THE SCRIPT FROM THE EDITOR!

HE DRAWS THE STRIP ALL IN PENCIL, FOLLOWING THE DIRECTIONS WHICH THE WRITER WROTE FOR HIM IN THE SCRIPT...



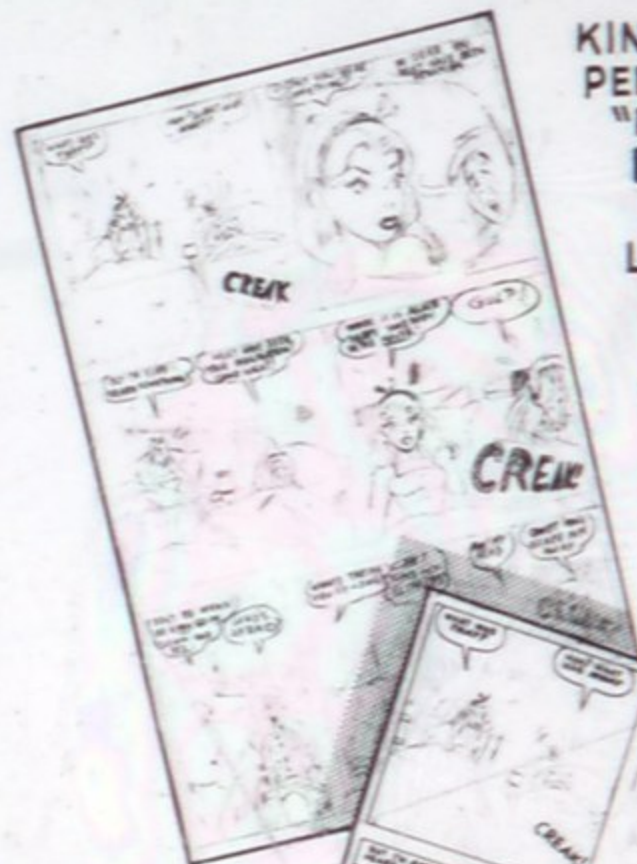
BUT AFTER THE STRIP HAS BEEN DRAWN IN PENCIL, THERE ARE STILL MANY MANY MORE STAGES WHICH IT MUST GO THRU!

THE NEXT PERSON TO WORK ON THE STRIP IS "THE LETTERER": HE IS THE ONE WHO LETTERS ALL THE WORDS VERY CLEARLY AND CLEVERLY SO THAT YOU CAN READ THEM EASILY!

MARIO ACQUAVIVA, ONE OF THE FINEST LETTERERS IN COMICS. HE LETTERS "RUSTY" AND MANY OTHER COMIC STRIPS!
